





#### NCR MAILING LISTS

NCR has the Northlander and its website to keep members updated on club events and current officers, board members and committee heads. But many members may not know there are two electronic mail lists which allow for last minute announcements as well as giving members a forum to ask a car-related question. Below I explain each list and how to sign on.

First thing you do is go to http://ncr-pca.org/mailman/listinfo

**NCR-Members** – Once you're on the link above this is the first list you see. The list is open to all members and can be used to discuss any topic you think of interest to other members. When you subscribe you're put on a send and receive mailing list.

Click the NCR-Members link and scroll down to "Subscribing to NCR-Members." Enter the e-mail address you want to use for this list and pick a password. Once you've set that up you'll receive messages from others subscribed to NCR-Members. The "Subscribe" page is also the "edit" and "unsubscribe" page so you want to add this link to your Bookmarks or Favorites. Also, to post a message to NCR-Members you send an e-mail to <u>ncr-members@ncr-pca.org</u>, so you'll want to add that e-mail address to your address book.

**NCR-News** – Going back to the link above you'll see the second list is NCR-News. This is a "one-way" e-mail. That means when you subscribe, the only e-mails you'll get from NCR-News will be club news-related announcements sent by the list administrator. These e-mails should NOT be replied to. If you are asked to contact anyone in an NCR-News e-mail, that person's information will be within the e-mail.

Click on the NCR-News link and scroll down to "Subscribing to NCR-News," just like you did with NCR-Members. You'll be asked to enter an e-mail address and password, like NCR-Members. Again, this page allows you to edit and unsubscribe so you'll want to add it to your Bookmarks or Favorites. You cannot post messages to NCR-News so there is no e-mail address for this list.

In case you're concerned about too many e-mails, both NCR-Members and NCR-News are quiet lists. Members post to NCR-Members maybe 6 times a year. NCR-News is more frequent but still only posts once or twice a month depending on how busy the club's social calendar is. NCR-Members allows you to ask about a car problem you're experiencing or ask advice about other carrelated topics. NCR-News is a great way to get information on a last minute social event and to remind of upcoming events.

So stay informed and get good advice from those who have "been there and done that." Join NCR-Members and NCR-News today.
